Summer Commencement 2025 Ticket Ordering Frequently Asked Questions

Is seating assigned or general admission?

Seating is assigned for all Commencement ceremonies.

What if my guest(s) need disability (ADA) or special accommodations seating or ASL (American Sign Language Interpretation)?

Please fill out the disability (ADA) or special accommodations form <u>HERE</u>. You will be contacted by a CBU ticketing representative to reserve your disability (ADA) or special accommodation seating. **ASL requests must be made by July 14, 2025.** There will be captioning available in English and Spanish at the ceremony.

If my guest(s) need disability (ADA) or special accommodations tickets, do I still use the ticketing password link sent to me in addition to filling out the form?

No. If requesting tickets with disability (ADA) or special accommodations seating, please fill out the disability (ADA) or special accommodations form HERE. DO NOT USE THE TICKETING PASSWORD LINK SENT TO YOU IF YOU ARE MAKING DISABILITY or SPECIAL ACCOMMODATIONS REQUESTS. If you claim tickets using the ticketing link in addition to your disability (ADA) or special accommodations seating tickets, your tickets may be canceled and not valid.

What is the maximum number of tickets I can claim?

The maximum number of tickets able to be claimed is 8. If more tickets become available, there will be further communication from the CBU Ticketing Office after the ticketing deadline of August 1. There is no guarantee that more tickets will become available, and we do not have a waiting list. Please do not contact the CBU Ticketing office or Commencement to ask for more tickets.

When is the last date to claim my commencement tickets online?

The final date is August 1. If tickets are not claimed by that date, there is no guarantee that you will receive tickets for your ceremony.

Will additional tickets become available?

After August 1, if it is determined that additional tickets are available, graduates will receive communication stating the start time of the extra ticket period, as well as how many additional tickets can be claimed per graduate. There may be a very limited number of seats available at the Ticketing Office 1 hour prior to your Commencement ceremony (first come, first served).

How will I receive my tickets if I use the Ticketing Link sent to my Lancer Mail?

If tickets are ordered using the link sent to your Lancer Mail, at checkout you will choose to receive them by text message and/or email. For complete instructions, please **CLICK HERE**.

Do children need a ticket?

If the attending child is under 2 years old, they do not need a ticket since they will not be using a seat. They must sit in a lap. Strollers are not permitted.

Are Service Animals permitted?

Yes. Service Animals are permitted. Emotional Support Animals and pets are not permitted.
