Unknown / Abandoned Materials Procedure

Purpose: To ensure that all CBU Faculty/Staff are aware that non-labeled containers could contain hazardous and/or toxic materials.

Procedure:

- 1. If an unlabeled (unknown/abandoned) container or package is discovered, please <u>do not touch</u> <u>it</u>. Contact F&PS immediately (x4360 or 951/343-4360) and report the location and detailed description of the container/package.
- 2. The Facilities office will then notify the Department of Safety Services (DSS).
- 3. Leave the container in an open area to ensure ventilation do not touch it or cover it.
- 4. Avoid unnecessary exposure and harm **do not smell or taste the contents of the container**.
- 5. Do not allow anyone to come in contact with the container until F&PS or DSS has responded.
- 6. Once F&PS or DSS has responded they will record the date and time the unknown/abandoned material was found.
- 7. F&PS and DSS will ensure all safety procedures are followed.
- 8. F&PS and DSS will determine if the unknown/abandoned container or package can be moved, or if it needs to remain at the location that it was found.
- 9. If it cannot be moved, F&PS will contact a Certified Environmental Safety company for immediate removal and testing.
- 10. If is determined that the unknown/abandoned container or package can be moved, F&PS management will remove the container/package. They will then contact a Certified Environmental Safety company for removal and testing **within 24 hours** of discovery.
- 11. It is the responsibility of F&PS to take appropriate and necessary precautions when handling unknown/abandoned materials.
