


Blackboard - Creating an Assignment

Directions

1. Start in Week or Module folder where the assignment is going to exist (See Creating a Folder for Each Week of Instruction for info on how to create this)



- 2. For Ungraded Assignments and other items such as files, videos, etc... choose Build Content Tab
 - a. Choose File, Item, Web Link, or other appropriate option.
 - b. Give item a Name, Type Description
 - c. Choose relevant attachments, if any.
 - d. Choose Whether to Permit Users (students) to view this content
 - e. Choose to track number of views
 - f. Chose date and time item is viewable
 - g. Click Submit
- 3. For Graded Assignments choose Assessments tab
 - a. Choose Assignment
 - b. Follow above steps 2-6
