1. Register for your MAJOR – Recommended 1st Semester Courses:

- **Appropriate first year major courses**
 - PSY213 General Psychology
 - MAT115 Intermediate Algebra (prereq: MAT095) or STA144 Introduction to Statistics (prereq: MAT115) - See Math placement in step 3.

2. Register for ALL REQUIRED 1st semester courses:

- FOCUS: *GST100 (FOCUS not required for 20 yrs or older)*
- CHAPEL: *GST050 - You must attend at least 15 chapel sessions per semester to pass.*
- ENGLISH COMPOSITION PLACEMENT: *ENG113 Composition*
ENG103, ENG113, or ENG123 is required each semester until ENG123 is successfully completed.

3. Register for GENERAL EDUCATION (GE) Courses – As many as you desire within your unit limit

A. Choose from among these Competency courses recommended in your first year:

- MATH PLACEMENT: *MAT115 Intermediate Algebra*
- * TECHNOLOGY: *NOT EXEMPT*
- * FOREIGN LANGUAGE I: *EXEMPT SPA115*
- * FOREIGN LANGUAGE II: *EXEMPT SPA125*
**This requirement may be exempt through high school coursework. If it is not exempt, review the Recommended General Education Classes list.*

B. Choose from among these GENERAL EDUCATION courses (see Recommended General Education Classes list):

- **Biblical and Theological Core -**
9 units required.
- **The Natural World -**
6 units required. No more than 4 units in one area, and cannot cross Competency or Foundation Requirement
- **The Social World -** Major will meet 3 Behavioral Sciences units
6 units required. No more than 3 units in one area
- **The Political World -**
6 units required. No more than 3 units in one area
- **The Cultural World -**
6 units required. No more than 3 units in one area
- **The Foundation Requirement -**
4 units of a Lab Science are required
