### Eligibility Information:

- **192** students are selected for the **Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN)** program annually – **96** students for the fall semester and **96** students for the spring semester.
- Selection is made through a **holistic admission process**. Criteria includes the **ATI TEAS entrance exam, science GPA, cumulative GPA, letters of recommendation, personal statement essay, experience, and completion of prerequisite courses**.
- All prerequisites must be completed with a grade of **"C" or better**.
- The **lab component** of lab science courses for all Major/Pre-Nursing requirements **must be held in the classroom**.
- **Students with CBU "Residency" are considered before transfer students**. "Residency" is defined as being **currently enrolled in 12 or more units OR completing 12 or more units in the year prior** to starting the BSN program.
- Although the **minimum cumulative GPA required to apply is 3.00, with a minimum Science GPA of 2.8**. The average GPA of the students accepted into the BSN program this past year are as follows:

- **Cumulative GPA** 3.5
- **Science GPA** 3.3
- **TEAS Exam** 78

This is a **very competitive program**. We encourage **all** Pre-Nursing students to explore back-up majors/plans.
