Eligibility Information:

- Approximately **30** students are selected for the **Bachelor of Science in Radiologic Sciences** program **annually**.
- Selection is made through a **holistic admission process**. Criteria includes **cumulative GPA, letters of recommendation, essay of intent, completion of observation hours, completion of prerequisite courses, and an interview with the Program Director**.
- The **minimum cumulative GPA required to apply is 2.50**.

This is a **very competitive program**. We encourage **all** Pre-Radiologic Science students to explore back-up majors/plans.
