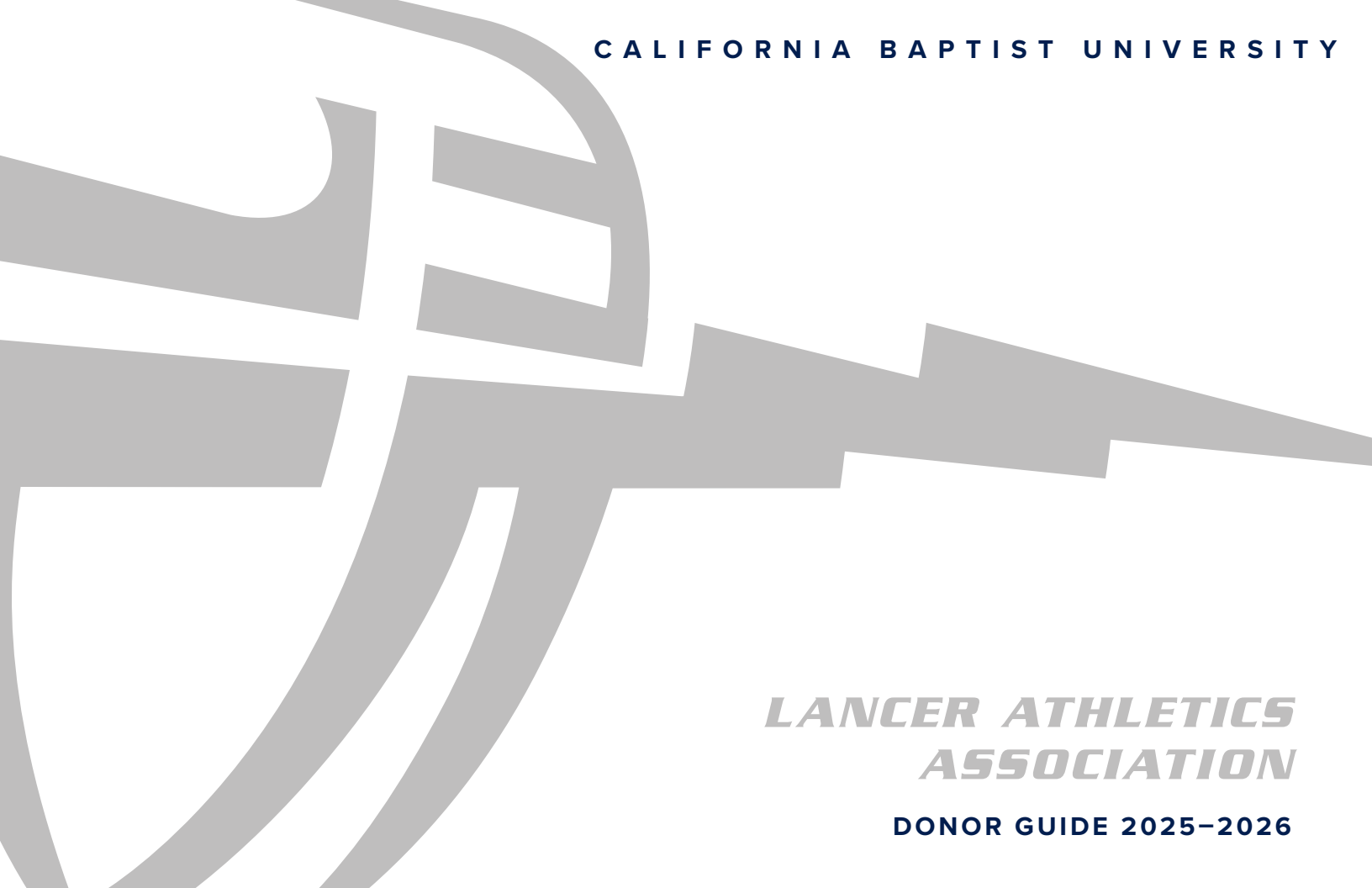

NCAA HOUSE SETTLEMENT OVERVIEW

NEW ROSTER LIMITS

NCAA is introducing new roster limits that match or exceed current scholarship restrictions for each sport.

DIRECT PAYMENT

Starting in 2025, schools can opt to share a “cap” of up to \$20.5 million with their student-athletes, beginning July 1, 2025.



NO SCHOLARSHIP CAP

NCAA D1 schools will be able to offer scholarships to every athlete on their roster, eliminating previous sport-specific limits.



SCHOLARSHIP TYPE

All sports will now be classified as equivalency sports, allowing schools to offer partial scholarships.



NIL

Student-athletes will still be able to profit off of their Name Image Likeness, but there will be changes to the regulation of the deals and enforcement.

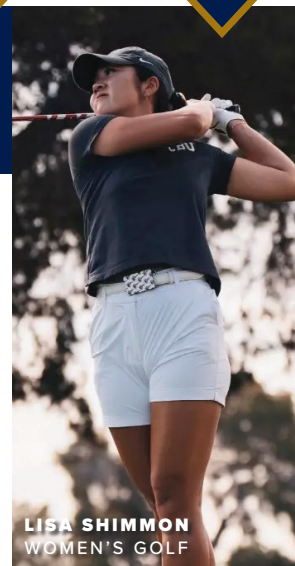

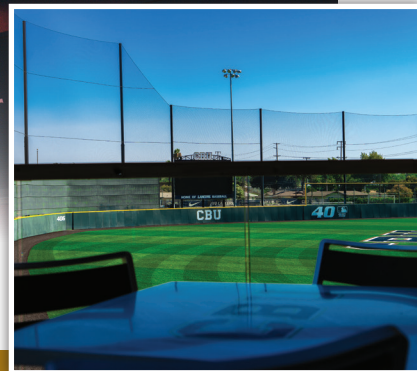
