1. Write an essay in 1000-1200 words that answers the following question:

What is one current problem in the world that you want your life to be a part in the solution of and how is the initial degree you are pursuing going to help you with solving that problem? Include in your essay how your intended area of study is likely to be addressing this problem in the future.

2. Create 3 poster titles, rank order, and explain:

If you had to present a poster at a conference to a group of your peers regarding the issue you address in your essay...

- List 3 possible titles for the poster knowing that the title will be used to draw interest to your topic
- Rank the titles in order from 1st choice to 3rd.
- Provide an explanation for your rationale behind the order choices.

3. Choose one of the following two topics and write a 300-500 word essay with your answer.

Give an example of an innovation that has personally positively impacted your life and why.

Name one person (besides a relative) that, to you, best exemplifies an effective leader that cares for people and why you think they are effective.

1. Must be a junior or senior during the 2017-18 school year.
2. Must register to compete by June 30th, 2017.
3. Must write and submit “Step 1” content by midnight PST, July 1, 2017 to aacosta@calbaptist.edu
4. Students selected based on “Step 1” will be invited to CBU campus for an interview and academic test in the fall of 2017.
