### **Quick Look 2016-2017\***

**Length of Program:** 36 units, 12 months full-time, part-time options available

**Approximate Cost:** \$643 per unit plus \$100 per unit program fee- \$26,748 and \$355 per semester general fee. HSC course tuition is \$800 per unit and will increase program cost accordingly.

**Priority Deadline:** Application completion dates: Fall- April 1, Spring- November 1, Summer-March 1

**Standard Deadline:** Application completion dates: Fall- August 1, Spring- December 1, Summer-April 1

**Program Starts:** Fall (September), Spring (January), Summer (May)

**Program Format:** Tuesday and/or Thursday 6:00 pm - 10:00 pm, eight week courses **OR** One year daytime program with internship

### **Application Requirements**

Applicants are considered for admission based on a review of the following:

1. Application for admission with a \$45 non-refundable application fee. Apply at [www.calbaptist.edu/gradapp](http://www.calbaptist.edu/gradapp).
2. Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution or the evaluated equivalency with a minimum GPA of 3.0 for unconditional admission and 2.5 for conditional admission.
3. Official sealed transcripts from all colleges and universities attended sent to *Graduate Admissions*
4. GMAT - may be waived for applicants with significant work experience and/or a high GPA
5. Two recommendations from academic or professional sources. Family and friends may not complete recommendations.
6. Comprehensive essay of at least 1000 words that includes the following:
  - Purpose for entering the program
  - Long-term professional goals
  - Reasons for choosing to study at CBU
  - Factors that make applicant a good MBA candidate

8. Successful interview with the MBA Program Director
9. An applicant whose first language is not English and/or does not have a degree from an institution where English is the primary language of instruction is required to demonstrate English proficiency by submitting a recent test score from Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or International English Language Testing System (IELTS).
