



Some financial assistance is based on financial need. Your eligibility for the Federal Pell Grant, Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant, Federal Work Study, Cal Grant, and the Federal Direct Loan Programs is determined by the results of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (www.fafsa.gov; CBU's school code is 001125). Federal Pell Grant

\$606 - \$5,920 per year

The Pell Grant is a federal grant program, which is awarded based on financial need as determined by the FAFSA.

Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (FSEOG)

\$1,000 per year

The FSEOG is a federal grant designed to help students with the highest need as determined by the FAFSA. Funds are limited.

Cal Grant

\$8,056 per year (for current 1st year recipients)

Cal Grant is funded by the State of California to California residents who meet GPA and financial criteria. To be considered, students must submit a FAFSA and a GPA Verification Form no later than March 2. Subject to change pending state budget approval. For more information go to www.csac.ca.gov.

Federal Direct Student Loan

Freshman may borrow up to	\$5,500
Sophomores may borrow up to	\$6,500
Juniors and Seniors may borrow up to	\$7,500

Independent students may borrow additional unsubsidized funds. Repayment of the loan begins six months after students leave school or fall below half-time status.

Direct Subsidized Loan

While students are in school, the government pays the interest on the loan. Based on need. Current interest rate of 3.76%.

Direct Unsubsidized Loan

Interest will accrue while students are in school. Not based on need. Current interest rate of 3.76%.

Federal Direct Parent Plus Loan

Federal loans for parents of dependent, undergraduate students. Repayment begins within 60 days after the final disbursement at a minimum of \$50 per month with a fixed interest rate of 6.31%.

Academic Scholarships

Up to \$13,500 per year

Freshman Only

Trustees Scholarship - \$13,500

4.0 GPA and above / 1200 SAT or 25 ACT

Presidents Scholarship - \$12,500

3.75 - 3.99 GPA / 1100 SAT or 24 ACT

Deans Scholarship - \$11,500

3.3 - 3.74 GPA / 1020 SAT or 21 ACT

Directors Scholarship - \$7,500

3.0 - 3.29 GPA / 990 SAT or 19 ACT

SAT scores listed are based on evidence-based reading & writing and the math sections. These scholarships are guaranteed if academic requirements are met. Renewable if a minimum GPA is maintained.

Transfer Only

Transfer Gold - \$9,500

3.5 GPA and above

Transfer Blue - \$7,500

3.0 - 3.49 GPA

To be considered a transfer student you must have completed 24 or more units from a regionally accredited college or university. Renewable if a minimum GPA is maintained.

CBU Grant

Up to \$4,000

The CBU Grant is based on financial need as determined by the FAFSA.

CBU Cal B Assistance

\$6,386 for the first year

For students that qualify for Cal Grant B from the State of California.

Minister's Kin

\$3,250 per year

The recipient must be the dependent child of a minister engaged in full-time services as a pastor; minister of education, music, children or youth; chaplain or missionary. For further information, contact the Admissions Office at 1.877.228.8866.

Multiple Sibling

\$2,000 per year

For families with two or more members who are simultaneously attending the traditional, undergraduate program on a full-time basis. For further information, contact the Admissions Office at 877.228.8866.
