- ✓ APPLICATION AND DOCUMENTS **SUBMITTED BY DEADLINE**
- ✓ PREREQUISITES COMPLETED WITH A "C" OR BETTER
- ✓ TEAS EXAM MINIMUM SCORE OF 64%
- ✓ MUST BE AGE 18 BEFORE THE PROGRAM BEGINS
- ✓ STUDENTS WHO HAVE BEEN DISMISSED FROM ANOTHER NURSING PROGRAM ARE NOT ELIGIBLE

#### FOR A FALL START (SEPTEMBER)

- FALL 2026: APPLY NOVEMBER 15, 2025 TO FEBRUARY 28, 2026
- ALL PREREQUISITES MUST BE COMPLETED BY END OF SPRING 2026 SEMESTER

#### FOR A **SPRING** START (JANUARY)

- SPRING 2027 APPLICATION OPENS JUNE 1 2026, CLOSES SEPTEMBER 1, 2026
- ALL PREREQUISITES MUST BE COMPLETED BY END OF FALL 2026 SEMESTER

# **ADMISSION TIMELINE**

- 1. APPLICATION IS SUBMITTED BY DEADLINE (OR EARLY DEADLINE)
- 2. FILE REVIEWED BY ADMISSIONS COMMITTEE
- 3.96 APPLICANTS CONDITIONALLY ACCEPTED FOR COHORT
- 4.10-20 APPLICANTS PLACED ON ALTERNATE LIST (ALTERNATES

  ARE CALLED UP AS SPACE BECOMES AVAILABLE)
- 5. APPLICANTS NOT SELECTED FOR THE COHORT OR ALTERNATE
