Application Requirements

Applicants are considered for admission based on a review of the following:

1. Application for admission with a \$45 non-refundable application fee. Apply at www.calbaptist.edu/gradapp.
2. Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution or the evaluated equivalency with a minimum GPA of 3.0 for unconditional admission and 2.5 for conditional admission.
3. Official transcripts from a college or university reflecting completion of baccalaureate degree. Additional transcripts may be required for prerequisite verification; see specific program for required prerequisites.
4. GMAT - may be waived for applicants with significant work experience and/or a high GPA
5. Two recommendations from academic or professional sources. Family and friends may not complete recommendations.
6. Comprehensive essay of at least 1000 words that includes the following:
 - Purpose for entering the program
 - Long-term professional goals
 - Reasons for choosing to study at CBU
 - Factors that make applicant a good MBA candidate

7. Current resume sent to graduateadmissions@calbaptist.edu
8. Successful interview with the MBA Program Director
9. An applicant whose first language is not English and/or does not have a degree from an institution where English is the primary language of instruction is required to demonstrate English proficiency by submitting a recent test score from Test of English as a Foreign Language
10. (TOEFL) or International English Language Testing System (IELTS).
