Length of Program: 30 units (5 semesters part time)

Approximate Cost: \$607 per unit - \$18,210 plus \$355 per semester general fee – hosted cohorts eligible for tuition discount

Program Starts: Fall (September) only

Priority Deadline: Application completion date; May 15

Standard Deadline: Application completion date; August 1

Program Format: Classes typically meet one night a week at 5:30 and 7:30, blending face-to-face and online instruction

GPA Requirement: 2.75. Options for overcoming a low GPA are available

GRE Requirement: GRE **not** required for applicants who meet GPA requirement

Accreditation: Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC)

Application Requirements

1. Application for admission with a \$45 non-refundable application fee. Apply at
2. www.calbaptist.edu/gradapp
3. Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution or evaluated equivalency
4. Minimum GPA of 2.75 for conditional admission. Applicants with a GPA below 2.75 may be considered for admission
5. Official sealed transcripts from a college or university reflecting completion of baccalaureate degree. Additional transcripts may be required for prerequisite or GPA verification.
6. Three recommendations from professional sources who can address your potential for success. Family members and friends may not complete recommendations.
7. Current resume
8. Comprehensive essay, maximum of one page single spaced, to address the following:
 - Purpose for entering the program
 - Reasons for choosing to study at CBU
9. An applicant whose first language is not English and/or does not have a degree from an institution where English is the primary language of instruction is required to demonstrate English proficiency by submitting a recent test score from Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or International English Language Testing System (IELTS)
