Application Requirements

1. Application for admission with a \$45 non-refundable application fee. Apply at www.calbaptist.edu/gradapp.
2. Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution or the evaluated equivalency, with a minimum GPA of 3.0 for unconditional admission. Applicants with a GPA below 2.75 may be considered for admission based on a combination of GPA, work experience, GRE score, and personal interview.
3. Official transcripts showing completion of a baccalaureate degree sent to *Graduate Admissions*. Additional transcripts may be required to verify prerequisites or GPA.
4. Three recommendations. One recommendation should be from a professor or instructor. Family and friends may not complete recommendations.
5. Comprehensive essay of at least 500 words that includes the following:
 - Purpose for entering the program
 - Experiences that have directed your interest toward Sport and Performance Psychology
 - Long-term professional goals
 - Religious background, present pattern of spiritual growth.
 - Reasons for choosing to study at CBU

6. Current resume documenting all professional and extracurricular experience
7. Successful interview(s) with the Director of the Graduate Program in Sport and Performance Psychology
8. An applicant whose first language is not English and/or does not have a degree from an institution where English is the primary language of instruction is required to demonstrate English proficiency.
