

## Peer Assessment Form

### Here are the rules for this process:

A student's overall peer assessment score will be based on the average peer grade from his or her teammates.

1. You are given 10 points to allocate for each person on your team, not counting yourself. For example, on a three-person team you will have 20 points to allocate between your two teammates. (Total points to allocate =  $10*(n-1)$  where  $n$  is the number of students on a team.)
2. You may allocate all of the points to one student if you feel that student did all of the work or spread them as you see fit.
3. Your instructor will sum the points and divide by  $n-1$  to get a score on a 0 to 10 scale except that students who are acknowledged by their peers to have done more than the norm can get more than 10 points.
4. Here are some factors you might consider in allocating your points:
  - Initiative and willingness to work
  - Active participation in team efforts
  - Devoted enough time to the team efforts
  - Leadership contribution
  - Design, implementation, and debug contribution
5. This form will be kept in strict confidence. Your teammates will not see your ratings.
6. Each student must turn in an assessment form. Those students who fail to turn in a form will receive a 0 for the team assessment portion of their grade.
